**Advisory and Guidelines regarding Residential/Category/Income & Assets/PwD/
In-service certificate for upcoming online Application form Submission for State
Merit List on the basis of NEET (PG) - 2026 Result.**

The J.C.E.C.E. Board will be conducting online counselling(s) for recommendation for admission in Post Graduate Medical (Degree/Diploma & DNB) courses on the basis of State Merit List based on National Eligibility cum Entrance Test [NEET (PG)-2026] Result, following its publication.

2. In order to streamline and simplify the process of online counselling(s), all eligible aspirants are advised to ensure that the following certificates/documents/card are required to updated at the time of applying for State Merit List in order to avoid any discrepancies, grievances, rejection or cancellation at a later stage.

a) Category or Income & Assets Certificate- The candidates are advised to get Local Resident/ST/SC/BCI(NCL)/BCII(NCL)/ I&A (for EWS) certificates updated. The certificates should be issued by an Officer not below the level of Sub-divisional Officer (Civil) of the Jharkhand State.

b) PwD Certificate (for Persons with Disabilities)- The candidates are advised to get PwD certificate updated. The certificates issued from RIMS, Ranchi will only be valid.

c) The candidates have to upload In-service certificates Issued by their Civil Surgeon for seeking benefit of In-service certificate.

d) The candidates who fill in a category in the State Merit List application form that differs from the category mentioned in their NEET (PG)-2026 application form will be considered under the Unreserved category, except in cases where there is a difference between the Central and State caste lists. In such cases, candidates will be considered under the claimed category only after uploading the original caste certificate along with the application form.

OBC candidates of NEET(PG)-2026 will be given the option to choose either BC-I or BC-II.
